Drivers Available in Fresno County!

Volunteer drivers are between the ages of 18 and 84, have a valid driver's license, pass a background check, and have access to a safe, reliable car. There are currently drivers available in Fresno, Clovis, Firebaugh, and Sanger!



Eligibility is easy!

Patients must be traveling to a cancerrelated medical appointment. Other eligibility requirements may apply. For example, a caregiver may need to accompany a patient who cannot walk without help, or is under age 18.
